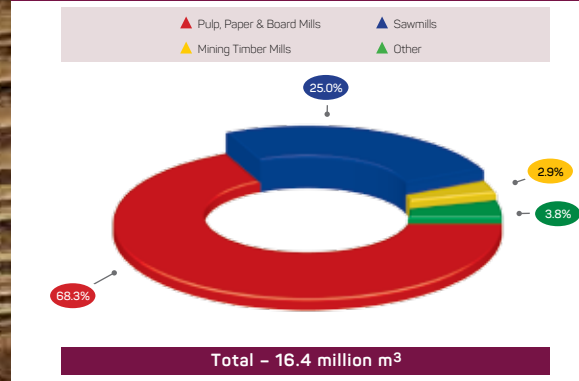

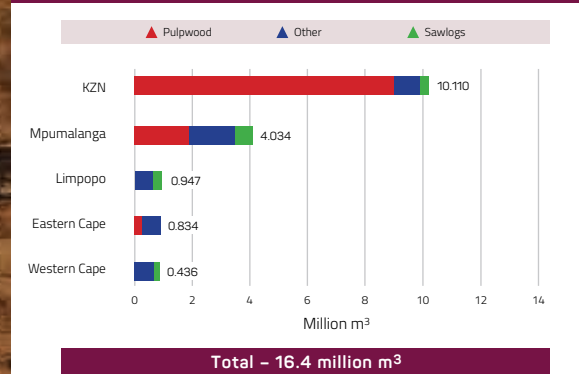

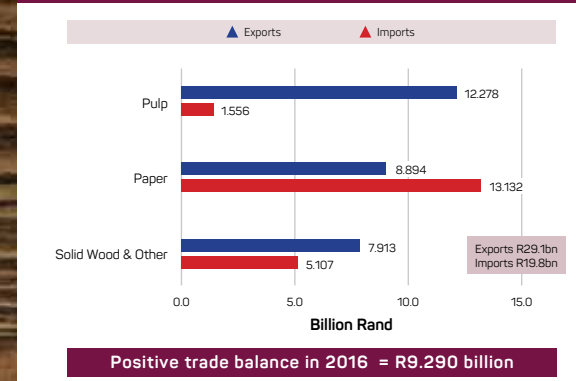
Intake of Roundwood into Processing Plants 2016



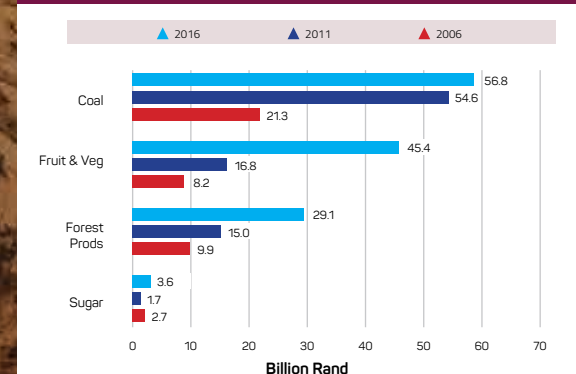
Roundwood Intake into Processing Plants by Province & Product 2016

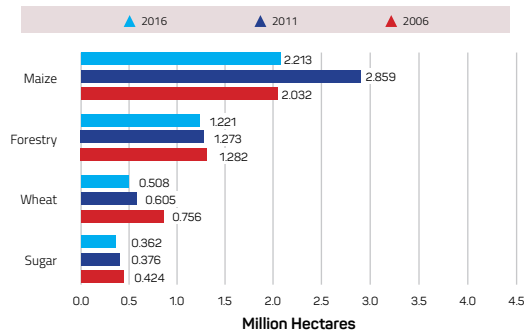

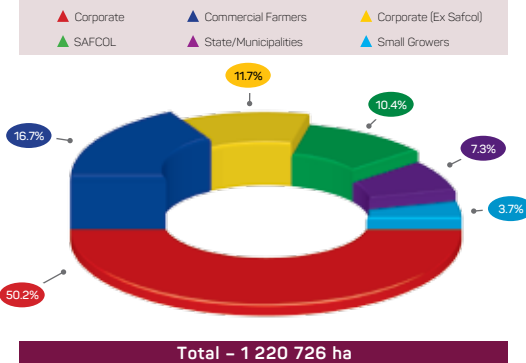

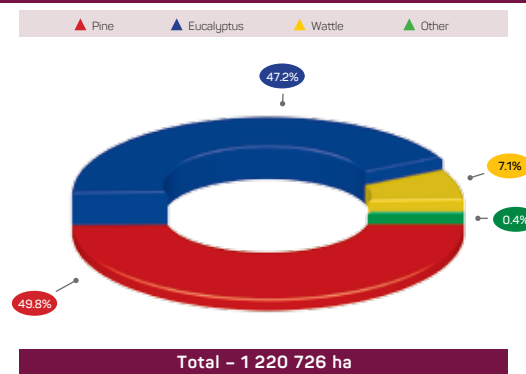

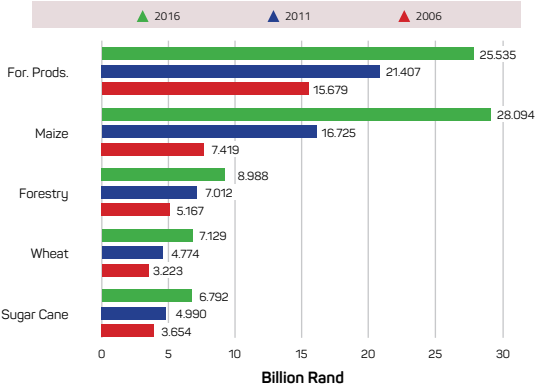

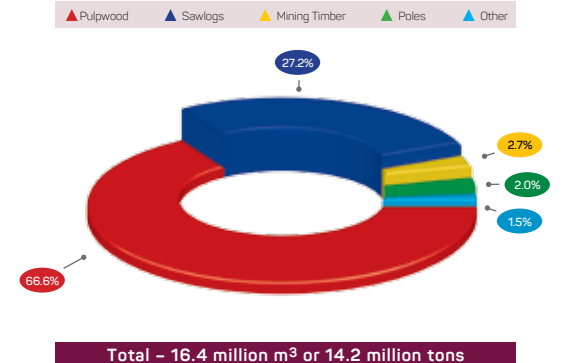

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Gross Value of Output Comparisons 2006, 2011 & 2016

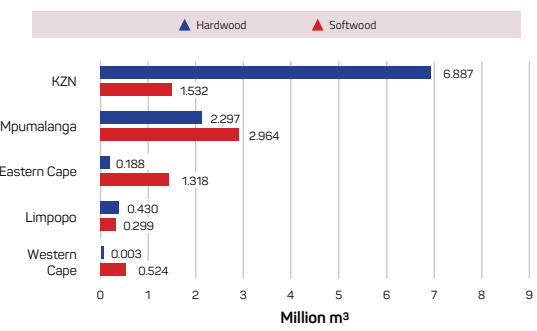


Total Roundwood Production ex Plantations by Product 2016



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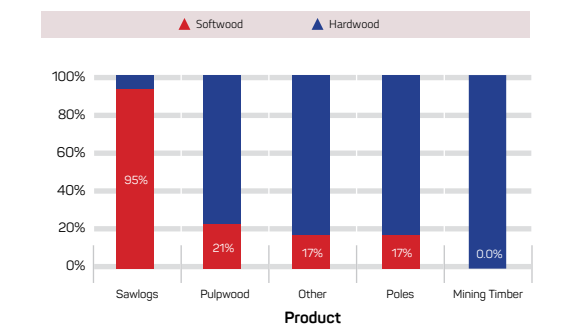
Roundwood Production by Province and Genera 2016
